A Note from the Director...

When Old Town Playhouse decided to produce a Young Company/ Mainstage crossover production, I was thrilled with the prospect of bringing a show like Roald Dahl's Matilda the Musical to life on our stage. I knew this show would present me with challenges I've yet to face as an educator, choreographer, and director - and boy was I right! The challenge of creating literal magic onstage, working with a cast of nearly 40 actors with a wide range of ages and stage experience, and staying true to the heart of the story while putting my own spin on it meant that things didn't always go as planned... but most times it became something better! Roald Dahl was a formative author of my youth and growing up with the books and movie adaptations of Matilda, The Witches, James and Giant Peach, and The BFG shaped the way I move through the world - with compassion, empathy, and a drive to ensure equity and justice. I have felt incredibly privileged to bring my own point of view to this story of the meaning of family, the importance of education, fighting injustices in the world, and embracing the power within yourself with a touch of magic that ties it all together.






